Asian Law & Economics Association (AsLEA) Proposal for AsLEA XIth Annual Conference Bangkok, 10& 11 August 2015

The AsLEA XIth Annual Conference will be held in Bangkok Thailand on 10& 11 August 2015, hosted by Chulalongkorn University. The purpose of the conference is the presentation and discussion of law & economics research, of a theoretical or empirical nature, relating primarily to questions originating Asia (including ASEAN), although topical issues within the conference themes are also welcome from other regions.

The economic analysis of court cases, legal rules, or administrative guidelines is welcome, as is the exploration of important economic and development topics with a nexus to legal rules, legal decision making, standard setting, rule-making, and regulations, as well as issues of governance and institutional capacity.

The conference will be of interest to economists, legal scholars, policy makers, legal practitioners and government officials. The Conference sessions are as follows:

- (1) The Legal Process, Litigation, Courts, Criminal Law, and Dispute Resolution
- (2) Sustainable Economic Development, and Environmental Protection
- (3) Corporate Law and Practices, Innovation, Competition, and Governance
- (4) Economics and Regulations

Within these broad themes, papers and presentations are welcome from a variety of subject areas, disciplines, and approaches, including:

- property law, contract law, tort law, and constitutional law
- antitrust law, corporate law, labor law, tax law, bankruptcy law
- law & finance, competition frameworks, intellectual property
- economics of environmental law, protection, and regulation
- environmental international agreements
- international law and political economy
- criminal law, crime deterrence, and law enforcement
- behavior of regulated firms, corporate governance
- legislation, legislative processes, courts, litigation, the legal process
- law and economic development
- economics and legal regulation
- family law and economics
- economics and international trade laws
- economics and government intervention

10 April 2015: Deadline for submission of paper abstracts or drafts

10 May 2015: Decision on acceptance of papers

10 July 2015: Deadline for submission of final draft papers

(1) Include on the first page of your submission your paper title, authors' names and affiliations, contact information, including email address for the corresponding author.

(2) For abstracts, preferably 250 words or less.

(3) If you are interested in publishing your conference papers to Asian Journal of Law and Economics, please clarify your interests when you submit your abstracts.
